In this sense, the emergence of database technology is probably a revolutionary development in the world of information processing by computers. Knowledge representation has also become a crucial issue in the field of artificial intelligence. In fact, whichever system we consider, how to represent knowledge and

then utilize it on a computer is a key problem for the realization of advanced information system such as natural language processing, image or speech understanding, machine vision, intelligent information retrieval, and intelligent manmachine communication.

Критерии оценивания

Суммарно оцениваются ответы на вопросы в карточке. Ответы должны быть развернутыми, полными. Оценивается полнота и адекватность ответа; умение строить грамматически правильные предложения; использование изученной лексики.
